

Tour of Speyside

Regulations

1. Announcement: Tour of Speyside event will be held on **Saturday 27th of July 2019** and is organised by **The Sixty-Three Car Club (Elgin) LTD**. The event will start & finish at Christie of Fochabers IV32 7PF with a lunch halt in the Grantown area.

2. Jurisdiction: The event will be held under the general rules of the Motorsport UK as a Touring Assembly and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. Motorsport UK Touring Assembly Permit No 120864

3. Eligibility: The event is open to all members and non members of 63 Car Club.

4. Documentation: Pre event document inspection and signing on will take place between 09:15 am & 09:45 am at Christies of Fochabers. Final Instructions will be emailed in the days prior to the event confirming times and map of start location.

5. Vehicle Requirement: Vehicle must have a valid MOT certificate and road fund licence for the duration of the event, Cars must comply with the Motorsport UK regulations for the event. All tyres must be road legal. Participants are responsible for ensuring that all drivers of the vehicles entered in the event are fully covered by insurance during the event as required by the Road Traffic Acts. Both crew members will also be required to sign a declaration at the start on the signing on sheet indemnifying the organisers and the Motorsport UK from liability. Rally Plates with numbers will be used to identify the cars. (To be affixed to the front of the vehicle).

6. Route, Navigation and Driving Behaviour: First car will start at 10am the route will be approx. 150 miles on public A and B class roads and unclassified roads. The route will be on sealed surfaces. The route will be defined by a route book which will be supplied at the event along with a map. Participants must at all times comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner. Failure to do so may result, after an official warning, in exclusion from the event.

7. Entries: The entry fee is **£15**. This includes Printed Road Book & Map, Rally Plate and sticker. It **does not** include any refreshments we have taken the decision not to include this in the price but a range of food will be available to purchase at the Start/Lunch Halt and Finish. All entries must be made on the entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee Maximum number of entries is 30 minimum is 15.

Entries will be accepted in order of payment any entries received after maximum has been reached will be placed on a reserve list. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form.
