The event will be part of the 63 Car Club Club Championship and Navigator Championship.

There will be four classes on this event:

| Expert Class - | For experienced competitors who would compete at the top level of navigational rallying. |
| Non Expert Class - | For competitors who are familiar with expert navigation, but require more controls throughout the event. |
| Novice Class - | For competitors who are relatively new to the navigational rallying but do have a general idea of basic navigation. |
| Beginner Class - | For competitors who are completely new and willing to learn about the navigation. Clues are basic and well explained. No additional equipment is required – just the map provided. |

An A4-sized digital map will be provided for the event thanks to **Nicolson Digital Ltd** which you can use digitally or print off to the correct size (Sized to 100%).

For those wishing to use a full size paper map, the map used is OS Map 27 Nairn & Forres (Revised July 2013, reprinted with a new legend and cover February 2016.).

Timescale for the event:

Entries open on the publication of these regulations.

Entries close at 8pm on Wednesday 24th March.

The event will start at 8pm on Thursday 25th March.

The event will close at 7pm on Sunday 28th March.

Results will be emailed as soon as possible after the end of the event.

Final instructions, an A4 digital map, route navigation and a set of route questions will be emailed to competitors at 8pm on Thursday 25th March.

For every wrong question answered on the route question sheet, the competitor will be penalised by 15 points. Results will be decided by furthest clean. In the event of a tie-break, a tie-break question will be sent out to those competitors.
