Bob Miller Memorial Rally Saturday 17th September 2022 **The 63 Car Club (Elgin) Ltd - Supplementary regulations.**

1. The 63 Car Club (Elgin) Ltd will organise a Clubman permit 12 Car Navigational Rally on Saturday 17th September starting from Mosstodloch Scout Hall
2. The meeting will be held under the general regulations of Motorsport UK incorporating the provisions of the International sporting code of the FIA, these supplementary regulations and any other written instructions the club may issue.
3. Motorsport UK permit has been issued 127851
4. The event is open to paid up members of the 63 Car Club and members of the following invited clubs:- HCC, SDMC, ADMC, 750MC, NESMC AND Saltire Rally Club
5. All competitors must produce a valid membership card and minimum Motorsport UK Clubman RS Licence
6. The event is a round of the 63 Car Club O/A & Rally Championship
7. The programme of the meeting will be:-
 - Scrutinering & Noise Tests opens – 20:00
 - Signing On opens – 20:00
 - Car 1 Starts – 21:01
8. The current O.S. Landranger map 28 Elgin & Dufftown latest edition is required. Any feature of the map or legend may be used to define the route taken.
9. The event will consist of Expert, Non Expert and Novice Classes. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical regulations and all cars must be taxed and have a current MOT certificate. The maximum number of entries is 12.
10. The entry list opens on publication of regulations and closes finally on the 13/09/2022. All entries must be made on official online entry forms. The entry fee will be £20.00 payment details will be on entry form

13. Provisional results will be published ASAP after the event. Protests to be made accordance with C5.1.2 to 5.2.3.
14. Entrants will be supplied with a route card / time card at the start and as required during the event. These documents provide all the information necessary to comply with R 6.2.9 to 6.3.1.
15. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be supplied. These should be displayed at all times in the window behind the navigators door.
16. Marking and penalties will be as the Motorsport UK General Regulations except;
 - R Chart 13 (d)** 15 marks
 - R Chart 13 (e)** 300 marks before scheduled time, 2 marks if before due time.
 - R 11.3 to 11.3.3** Code boards will be used to ensure compliance with the correct route. Sample boards will be displayed at the start
 - R 15.2.2** In the event of a tie, results will be by furthest clean basis, if tie remains then navigation test will be used.
 - R 11.1.1** Competitors will not be penalised for stopping within sight of a control. They may wait in the control until their due time.
17. In Quiet Zones marked QZ START, competitors must drive quietly using no auxiliary lights. All 30 and 40 mph limits are deemed to be quiet zones.
18. Competitors must declare, when Signing-On, that they have their own Insurance Documents, showing that they have extended their own Private Motor Insurance, or sign and pay for cover under the Rally Guard Road Section Insurance Scheme. Failure to do so will result in the refusal of a start.

The Organisers have applied to Marsh Commercial for a Blanket Cover Note under the above scheme. This will provide competitors who need to use the scheme with the Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the event.

All applicants wishing to use the scheme must be able to comply with all points of the Marsh Commercial Motorsport's Declaration: -

I do not have the Third Party Road Section extension on my current Motor Insurance.

I am aged 20 or over.

I have had no more than 1 fault claim in the last three years

I have no more than a maximum of 6 conviction points or a licence ban on my UK driving licence

I have the appropriate competition/club membership licence as well as a UK/EU driving license and if my license is provisional I will be supervised by an adult over 25.

I have no physical or mental disabilities

My vehicle is MOT'd, Taxed and Insured for the road

I have no other material facts to disclose Anyone aged less than 20 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25.

If you comply with all points above no Letter of Acceptance will be required. PLEASE NOTE :- There is a change to the process this year. If you wish to have Marsh insurance you MUST complete and sign the Declaration Form and return it to the organisers at the same time as you submit your entry. The fee is £17.00

19. Mobile phones will be permitted in competitors cars, but may only be used in an emergency.

20. The correct route will be the shortest route at all times whilst complying with organiser's instructions. Straight on is implied at all times unless otherwise stated. The total mileage will be approximately 60 miles. Fuel will not be available at the start. The nearest petrol stations are Elgin & Keith (24hrs)
