

63 Car Club (Elgin) LTD
Championship Regulations
2026 V2 Published

1.0 Eligibility

1. The Championships are open to any fully paid up members of the 63 Car Club (Elgin) Ltd. (63CC)
2. No points are to be awarded to any member prior to the date they have joined the club for that year
3. The Junior Championship is open to all 63CC members aged 23 and under at the 31st of December of the current calendar year.
4. Competitors must enter under 63 Car Club (Elgin) Ltd
5. To be eligible to qualify for the club championship it is required to score points in two of the three elements a) Rally b) Autotest (includes PCA/Autosolo) (c) Offical (includes marshalling)

2.0 Entries for Events

Event regulations and entry forms will be available before the event takes place.

3.0 Number of events to count

The dropped scores in each championship are to be inline with the table above.

4.0 Points System

The points system for all championships except the championships detailed below -will be as follows: 1st 15 2nd 12 3rd 10 4th 9 5th 8 6th and below 7, DNF 6, COC 15, Sec 10 Marshal 5

Autotest Classes 1st 10, 2nd 8, 3rd 7, 4th and below 6 DNF 1

Marshals will score 5 Points in the Marshals Championship

AutoForward (Class 1 &2) Competitors in the Club/Drivers/One-Make/Junior will be as follows 1st 12 2nd 10 3rd 9 4th 8 5th and below 7, DNF 6, Passengers 5 points

Autotest Class F – No championship Class F 5 points for starting awarded in Club/Drivers/One-make/Junior

For dropped scores the competitor's lowest scores will be dropped.

All officials, entrants and marshals on the Speyside Stages will receive 10 points.

5.0 Best Result to Count

If a competitor enters more than once in an event only their best score will count.

Where an event features multiple permits (example Autotest/PCA/Autosolo) It is only permitted to score points on one event this must be indicated at the start of the event. If retire from indicated event that will still count as the points scored for the event. This rule applies for drivers and passengers

6.0 Ties in Events

In the event of a tie between competitors points will be awarded as per the results of the tie break that takes place on the event.

7.0 Championship ties

In the event of a tie the award will go to both competitor's.

The Competitor's will all have equal hold of the trophy in the event of a tie.

8.0 Club Championship Schedule

The calendar of events for the season will be published in the first newsletter of the year and will also be found on the club website.

All scores to be dropped inline with table under 3.0

1. Club Championship, All events count
2. Ladies Championship, Highest placed lady in the O/A Club Championship
3. Drivers Championship, All events count
4. Autotest Championship, All autotest's to count
5. Navigators Championship, All rallies to count
6. Novice Driver and Navigator, All rallies to count. Competitors can only score points as novice for three consecutive seasons or until they win the championship twice before their 3 years are up. (ie a maximum of two consecutive titles) Any competitor may enter Novice on an event

7. Junior Championship, All events to count. Juniors must be 23 and under on the 31th of December at the end of the championship year.
8. Marshals Championship, All events to count.
9. Ford and BMC Trophies, (One-make) Drivers must use Ford or Japanese cars to score points. All events to count.
10. AutoForward Championship, All sealed surface events to count, Championship results combination of Class 1 and Class 2, points awarded as per 4.0. (1st =15 etc) see note about other championships

9.0 Autotest Class structure

Class 1 – Production Car Autotest MUST CARRY PASSENGER Forward Only Tests

Class 2 – Autosolo MUST BE DRIVEN TO EVENT Forward Only Tests

Class 3 – Autotest RWD & 4WD Specials

Class 4 –Autotest FWD Specials

Class 5 – Autotest Road Car (MOT & Tax)

Class F Autotest Forward Only Tests (for cars not eligible in class 1 or 2 but meet Autotest regulations)

10.0 Notes

The committee reserve the right to add or remove events in order to maintain the most viable structure for the club

Championship runs for calendar year and will be reviewed by committee ahead of new season
