



Tour of Speyside Regulations

- 1. Announcement:** Tour of Speyside event will be held on **Saturday 1st August 2026** and is organised by **The Sixty-Three Car Club (Elgin) LTD**. The event will start at KNC Groundworks Park View Alford AB338QE. Lunch halt at Cullen Bay Hotel, Finish at Archiestown.
- 2. Jurisdiction:** The event will be held under the National competition rules of the Motorsport UK as a Touring Assembly and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event. Motorsport UK Touring Assembly Permit No Applied
- 3. Eligibility:** The event is open to all members and non members of 63 Car Club.
- 4. Documentation:** Pre event documentation will take place between 09:00am & 09:45am at KNC Groundworks Alford. Final Instructions will be emailed in the days prior to the event confirming times and map of start location.
- 5. Vehicle Requirement:** Vehicle must have a valid MOT certificate (unless exempt) and road fund licence for the duration of the event, Cars must comply with the Motorsport UK regulations for the event. All tyres must be road legal. Participants are responsible for ensuring that all drivers of the vehicles entered in the event are fully covered by insurance during the event as required by the Road Traffic Acts. Both crew members will also be required to read a declaration on the entry system indemnifying the organisers and the Motorsport UK from liability. Rally Plates with numbers will be used to identify the cars. (To be affixed to the front of the vehicle).
- 6. Route, Navigation and Driving Behaviour:** First car will start at 10am the route will be approx. 150 miles on public A and B class roads and unclassified roads. The route will be on sealed surfaces. The route will be defined by a route book which will be supplied at the event along with a map. Participants must at all times comply with the requirements of the Road Traffic Acts and drive in a responsible and considerate manner.
- 7. Entries:** The entry fee is **£49**. This includes Lunch (Soup & Sandwiches) Printed Road Book, Rally Plate and sticker. It **does not** include food at Start and Finish. All entries must be made on the entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee Maximum number of entries is 50 minimum is 20.

The entry list closes at noon on the 19th of July 2026 Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.
